## Why the Spiritual Disciplines are Needed

### **Ephesians 6:4**

4 Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

### **Hebrews 12:5-11**

5 And have you forgotten the exhortation that addresses you as sons? "My son, do not regard lightly the discipline of the Lord, nor be weary when reproved by him.

6 For the Lord disciplines the one he loves, and chastises every son whom he receives."

7 It is for discipline that you have to endure. God is treating you as sons. For what son is there whom his father does not discipline?

8 If you are left without discipline, in which all have participated, then you are illegitimate children and not sons.

9 Besides this, we have had earthly fathers who disciplined us and we respected them. Shall we not much more be subject to the Father of spirits and live?

10 For they disciplined us for a short time as it seemed best to them, but he disciplines us for our good, that we may share his holiness.

11 For the moment all discipline seems painful rather than pleasant, but later it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.

### **1 Timothy 4:7-8**

Have nothing to do with irreverent, silly myths. Rather train yourself for godliness;

8 for while bodily training is of some value, godliness is of value in every way, as it holds promise for the present life and also for the life to come.

### 2 Peter 1:19-21 Christ's Glory and Prophetic Word

19 And we have the **prophetic word more fully confirmed, to which you will do well to pay attention** as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts,

20 knowing this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture comes from someone's own interpretation.

21 For no prophecy was ever produced by the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.

# BIBLE VERSES RELATED TO Bible Study

Ezra 7:10 For Ezra had set his heart to study the Law of the LORD, and to do it and to teach his statutes and rules in Israel.

Nehemiah 8:13 On the second day the heads of fathers' houses of all the people, with the priests and the Levites, came together to Ezra the scribe in order to study the words of the Law.

## Scripture

Mrk\_12:10 Have you not read this Scripture: "The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone;

Luk\_4:21 And he began to say to them, "Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing."

Luk\_22:37 For I tell you that this Scripture must be fulfilled in me: 'And he was numbered with the transgressors.' For what is written about me has its fulfillment."

Jhn\_2:22 When therefore he was raised from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this, and they believed the Scripture and the word that Jesus had spoken.

Jhn\_7:38 Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, 'Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.'"

Jhn\_10:35 If he called them gods to whom the word of God came—and Scripture cannot be broken—

Jhn\_13:18 I am not speaking of all of you; I know whom I have chosen. But the Scripture will be fulfilled, 'He who ate my bread has lifted his heel against me.'

Jhn\_17:12 While I was with them, I kept them in your name, which you have given me. I have guarded them, and not one of them has been lost except the son of destruction, that the Scripture might be fulfilled.

Jhn\_19:24 so they said to one another, "Let us not tear it, but cast lots for it to see whose it shall be." This was to fulfill the Scripture which says, "They divided my garments among them, and for my clothing they cast lots." So the soldiers did these things,

Jhn\_19:28 After this, Jesus, knowing that all was now finished, said (to fulfill the Scripture), "I thirst."

Jhn\_19:36 For these things took place that the Scripture might be fulfilled: "Not one of his bones will be broken."

Jhn\_19:37 And again another Scripture says, "They will look on him whom they have pierced."

Jhn\_20:9 for as yet they did not understand the Scripture, that he must rise from the dead.

Act\_1:16 "Brothers, the Scripture had to be fulfilled, which the Holy Spirit spoke beforehand by the mouth of David concerning Judas, who became a guide to those who arrested Jesus.

Act\_8:32 Now the passage of the Scripture that he was reading was this: "Like a sheep he was led to the slaughter and like a lamb before its shearer is silent, so he opens not his mouth.

Act\_8:35 Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning with this Scripture he told him the good news about Jesus.

Rom\_4:3 For what does the Scripture say? "Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness."

Gal\_3:22 But the Scripture imprisoned everything under sin, so that the promise by faith in Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe.

Gal\_4:30 But what does the Scripture say? "Cast out the slave woman and her son, for the son of the slave woman shall not inherit with the son of the free woman."

1Ti\_4:13 Until I come, devote yourself to the public reading of Scripture, to exhortation, to teaching.

1Ti\_5:18 For the Scripture says, "You shall not muzzle an ox when it treads out the grain," and, "The laborer deserves his wages."

2Ti\_3:16 All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness,

Jas\_2:8 If you really fulfill the royal law according to the Scripture, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself," you are doing well.

Jas\_2:23 and the Scripture was fulfilled that says, "Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness"—and he was called a friend of God.

Jas\_4:5 Or do you suppose it is to no purpose that the Scripture says, "He yearns jealously over the spirit that he has made to dwell in us"?

1Pe\_2:6 For it stands in Scripture: "Behold, I am laying in Zion a stone, a cornerstone chosen and precious, and whoever believes in him will not be put to shame."

Mat\_21:42 Jesus said to them, "Have you never read in the Scriptures: "'The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone; this was the Lord's doing, and it is marvelous in our eyes'?

Mat\_22:29 But Jesus answered them, "You are wrong, because you know neither the Scriptures nor the power of God.

Mat\_26:54 But how then should the Scriptures be fulfilled, that it must be so?"

Mat\_26:56 But all this has taken place that the Scriptures of the prophets might be fulfilled." Then all the disciples left him and fled.

Mrk\_12:24 Jesus said to them, "Is this not the reason you are wrong, because you know neither the Scriptures nor the power of God?

Mrk\_14:49 Day after day I was with you in the temple teaching, and you did not seize me. But let the Scriptures be fulfilled."

Luk\_24:27 And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself.

Luk\_24:32 They said to each other, "Did not our hearts burn within us while he talked to us on the road, while he opened to us the Scriptures?"

Luk\_24:45 Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures,

Jhn\_5:39 You search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; and it is they that bear witness about me,

Acts 17:1-3

1 Now when they had passed through Amphipolis and Apollonia, they came to Thessalonica, where there was a synagogue of the Jews.

2 And Paul went in, as was his custom, and on three Sabbath days he reasoned with them from the Scriptures,

3 explaining and proving that it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead, and saying, "This Jesus, whom I proclaim to you, is the Christ."

Act\_17:11 Now these Jews were more noble than those in Thessalonica; they received the word with all eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily to see if these things were so.

Act\_18:24 Now a Jew named Apollos, a native of Alexandria, came to Ephesus. He was an eloquent man, competent in the Scriptures.

Act\_18:28 for he powerfully refuted the Jews in public, showing by the Scriptures that the Christ was Jesus.

Rom\_1:2 which he promised beforehand through his prophets in the holy Scriptures,

Rom\_15:4 For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.

1Co\_15:3 For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures,

1Co\_15:4 that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures,

2Pe\_3:16 as he does in all his letters when he speaks in them of these matters. There are some things in them that are hard to understand, which the ignorant and unstable twist to their own destruction, as they do the other Scriptures.

## **Word of God**

1Sa\_9:27 As they were going down to the outskirts of the city, Samuel said to Saul, "Tell the servant to pass on before us, and when he has passed on, stop here yourself for a while, that I may make known to you the word of God."

Pro\_30:5 Every word of God proves true; he is a shield to those who take refuge in him.

Mat\_15:6 he need not honor his father.' So for the sake of your tradition you have made void the word of God.

Mrk\_7:13 thus making void the word of God by your tradition that you have handed down. And many such things you do."

Luk\_3:2 during the high priesthood of Annas and Caiaphas, the word of God came to John the son of Zechariah in the wilderness.

Luk\_5:1 On one occasion, while the crowd was pressing in on him to hear the word of God, he was standing by the lake of Gennesaret,

Luk\_8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God.

Luk\_8:21 But he answered them, "My mother and my brothers are those who hear the word of God and do it."

Luk\_11:28 But he said, "Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and keep it!"

Jhn\_10:35 If he called them gods to whom the word of God came—and Scripture cannot be broken—

Act\_4:31 And when they had prayed, the place in which they were gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and continued to speak the word of God with boldness.

Act\_6:2 And the twelve summoned the full number of the disciples and said, "It is not right that we should give up preaching the word of God to serve tables.

Act\_6:7 And the word of God continued to increase, and the number of the disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem, and a great many of the priests became obedient to the faith.

Act\_8:14 Now when the apostles at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent to them Peter and John,

Act\_11:1 Now the apostles and the brothers who were throughout Judea heard that the Gentiles also had received the word of God.

Act\_12:24 But the word of God increased and multiplied.

Act\_13:5 When they arrived at Salamis, they proclaimed the word of God in the synagogues of the Jews. And they had John to assist them.

Act\_13:7 He was with the proconsul, Sergius Paulus, a man of intelligence, who summoned Barnabas and Saul and sought to hear the word of God.

Act\_13:46 And Paul and Barnabas spoke out boldly, saying, "It was necessary that the word of God be spoken first to you. Since you thrust it aside and judge yourselves unworthy of eternal life, behold, we are turning to the Gentiles.

Act\_17:13 But when the Jews from Thessalonica learned that the word of God was proclaimed by Paul at Berea also, they came there too, agitating and stirring up the crowds.

Act\_18:11 And he stayed a year and six months, teaching the word of God among them.

Rom\_9:6 But it is not as though the word of God has failed. For not all who are descended from Israel belong to Israel,

1Co\_14:36 Or was it from you that the word of God came? Or are you the only ones it has reached?

Eph\_6:17 and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God,

Col\_1:25 of which I became a minister according to the stewardship from God that was given to me for you, to make the word of God fully known,

1Th\_2:13 And we also thank God constantly for this, that when you received the word of God, which you heard from us, you accepted it not as the word of men but as what it really is, the word of God, which is at work in you believers.

1Ti\_4:5 for it is made holy by the word of God and prayer.

2Ti\_2:9 for which I am suffering, bound with chains as a criminal. But the word of God is not bound!

Tit\_2:5 to be self-controlled, pure, working at home, kind, and submissive to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be reviled.

Heb\_4:12 For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

Heb\_6:5 and have tasted the goodness of the word of God and the powers of the age to come,

Heb\_11:3 By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things that are visible.

Heb\_13:7 Remember your leaders, those who spoke to you the word of God. Consider the outcome of their way of life, and imitate their faith.

1Pe\_1:23 since you have been born again, not of perishable seed but of imperishable, through the living and abiding word of God;

2Pe\_3:5 For they deliberately overlook this fact, that the heavens existed long ago, and the earth was formed out of water and through water by the word of God,

1Jn\_2:14 I write to you, fathers, because you know him who is from the beginning. I write to you, young men, because you are strong, and the word of God abides in you, and you have overcome the evil one.

Rev\_1:2 who bore witness to the word of God and to the testimony of Jesus Christ, even to all that he saw.

Rev\_1:9 I, John, your brother and partner in the tribulation and the kingdom and the patient endurance that are in Jesus, was on the island called Patmos on account of the word of God and the testimony of Jesus.

Rev\_6:9 When he opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the witness they had borne.

Rev\_19:13 He is clothed in a robe dipped in blood, and the name by which he is called is The Word of God.

Rev\_20:4 Then I saw thrones, and seated on them were those to whom the authority to judge was committed. Also I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for the testimony of Jesus and for the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or its image and had not received its mark on their foreheads or their hands. 1Ki\_3:12 behold, I now do according to your word. Behold, I give you a wise and discerning mind, so that none like you has been before you and none like you shall arise after you.

1Ki\_8:26 Now therefore, O God of Israel, let your word be confirmed, which you have spoken to your servant David my father.

Psa\_119:17 Gimel Deal bountifully with your servant, that I may live and keep your word.

Psa\_119:25 Daleth My soul clings to the dust; give me life according to your word!

Psa\_119:28 My soul melts away for sorrow; strengthen me according to your word!

Psa\_119:42 then shall I have an answer for him who taunts me, for I trust in your word.

Psa\_119:49 Zayin Remember your word to your servant, in which you have made me hope.

Psa\_119:65 Teth You have dealt well with your servant, O LORD, according to your word.

Psa\_119:67 Before I was afflicted I went astray, but now I keep your word.

Psa\_119:74 Those who fear you shall see me and rejoice, because I have hoped in your word.

Exo\_9:20 Then whoever feared the word of the LORD among the servants of Pharaoh hurried his slaves and his livestock into the houses,

Exo\_9:21 but whoever did not pay attention to the word of the LORD left his slaves and his livestock in the field.

Num\_3:16 So Moses listed them according to the word of the LORD, as he was commanded.

Num\_3:51 And Moses gave the redemption money to Aaron and his sons, according to the word of the LORD, as the LORD commanded Moses.

Num\_15:31 Because he has despised the word of the LORD and has broken his commandment, that person shall be utterly cut off; his iniquity shall be on him."

Exo\_18:16 when they have a dispute, they come to me and I decide between one person and another, and I make them know the statutes of God and his laws."

Exo\_18:20 and you shall warn them about the statutes and the laws, and make them know the way in which they must walk and what they must do.

Lev\_10:11 and you are to teach the people of Israel all the statutes that the LORD has spoken to them by Moses."

Lev\_18:3 You shall not do as they do in the land of Egypt, where you lived, and you shall not do as they do in the land of Canaan, to which I am bringing you. You shall not walk in their statutes.

Lev\_18:4 You shall follow my rules and keep my statutes and walk in them. I am the LORD your God.

Lev\_18:5 You shall therefore keep my statutes and my rules; if a person does them, he shall live by them: I am the LORD.

Lev\_18:26 But you shall keep my statutes and my rules and do none of these abominations, either the native or the stranger who sojourns among you

Psa\_18:22 For all his rules were before me, and his statutes I did not put away from me.

Psa\_50:16 But to the wicked God says: "What right have you to recite my statutes or take my covenant on your lips?

Psa\_89:31 if they violate my statutes and do not keep my commandments,

Psa\_105:45 that they might keep his statutes and observe his laws. Praise the LORD!

Psa\_119:5 Oh that my ways may be steadfast in keeping your statutes!

Psa\_119:8 I will keep your statutes; do not utterly forsake me!

Psa\_119:12 Blessed are you, O LORD; teach me your statutes!

Psa\_119:16 I will delight in your statutes; I will not forget your word.

Psa\_119:80 May my heart be blameless in your statutes, that I may not be put to shame!

Psa\_119:83 For I have become like a wineskin in the smoke, yet I have not forgotten your statutes.

Psa\_119:112 I incline my heart to perform your statutes forever, to the end.

Psa\_119:117 Hold me up, that I may be safe and have regard for your statutes continually!

Psa\_119:118 You spurn all who go astray from your statutes, for their cunning is in vain.

Psa\_119:124 Deal with your servant according to your steadfast love, and teach me your statutes.

Psa\_119:135 Make your face shine upon your servant, and teach me your statutes.

Psa\_119:145 Qoph With my whole heart I cry; answer me, O LORD! I will keep your statutes.

Psa\_119:155 Salvation is far from the wicked, for they do not seek your statutes.

Psa\_119:171 My lips will pour forth praise, for you teach me your statutes.

Psa\_147:19 He declares his word to Jacob, his statutes and rules to Israel.

Isa\_24:5 The earth lies defiled under its inhabitants; for they have transgressed the laws, violated the statutes, broken the everlasting covenant.

Jer\_44:10 They have not humbled themselves even to this day, nor have they feared, nor walked in my law and my statutes that I set before you and before your fathers.

Jer\_44:23 It is because you made offerings and because you sinned against the LORD and did not obey the voice of the LORD or walk in his law and in his statutes and in his testimonies that this disaster has happened to you, as at this day."

Ezk\_5:6 And she has rebelled against my rules by doing wickedness more than the nations, and against my statutes more than the countries all around her; for they have rejected my rules and have not walked in my statutes.

Ezk\_5:7 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: Because you are more turbulent than the nations that are all around you, and have not walked in my statutes or obeyed my rules, and have not even acted according to the rules of the nations that are all around you,

Ezk\_11:12 and you shall know that I am the LORD. For you have not walked in my statutes, nor obeyed my rules, but have acted according to the rules of the nations that are around you."

Ezk\_11:20 that they may walk in my statutes and keep my rules and obey them. And they shall be my people, and I will be their God.

Ezk\_18:9 walks in my statutes, and keeps my rules by acting faithfully—he is righteous; he shall surely live, declares the Lord GOD.

Ezk\_18:17 withdraws his hand from iniquity, takes no interest or profit, obeys my rules, and walks in my statutes; he shall not die for his father's iniquity; he shall surely live.

Ezk\_18:19 "Yet you say, 'Why should not the son suffer for the iniquity of the father?' When the son has done what is just and right, and has been careful to observe all my statutes, he shall surely live.

Ezk\_18:21 "But if a wicked person turns away from all his sins that he has committed and keeps all my statutes and does what is just and right, he shall surely live; he shall not die.

Ezk\_20:11 I gave them my statutes and made known to them my rules, by which, if a person does them, he shall live.

Ezk\_20:13 But the house of Israel rebelled against me in the wilderness. They did not walk in my statutes but rejected my rules, by which, if a person does them, he shall live; and my Sabbaths they greatly profaned. "Then I said I would pour out my wrath upon them in the wilderness, to make a full end of them.

Ezk\_20:16 because they rejected my rules and did not walk in my statutes, and profaned my Sabbaths; for their heart went after their idols.

Ezk\_20:18 "And I said to their children in the wilderness, 'Do not walk in the statutes of your fathers, nor keep their rules, nor defile yourselves with their idols.

Ezk\_20:19 I am the LORD your God; walk in my statutes, and be careful to obey my rules,

Ezk\_20:21 But the children rebelled against me. They did not walk in my statutes and were not careful to obey my rules, by which, if a person does them, he shall live; they profaned my Sabbaths. "Then I said I would pour out my wrath upon them and spend my anger against them in the wilderness.

Ezk\_20:24 because they had not obeyed my rules, but had rejected my statutes and profaned my Sabbaths, and their eyes were set on their fathers' idols.

Ezk\_20:25 Moreover, I gave them statutes that were not good and rules by which they could not have life,

Ezk\_33:15 if the wicked restores the pledge, gives back what he has taken by robbery, and walks in the statutes of life, not doing injustice, he shall surely live; he shall not die.

Ezk\_36:27 And I will put my Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to obey my rules.

Ezk\_37:24 "My servant David shall be king over them, and they shall all have one shepherd. They shall walk in my rules and be careful to obey my statutes.

Ezk\_43:11 And if they are ashamed of all that they have done, make known to them the design of the temple, its arrangement, its exits and its entrances, that is, its whole design; and make known to them as well all its statutes and its whole design and all its laws, and write it down in their sight, so that they may observe all its laws and all its statutes and carry them out.

Ezk\_44:5 And the LORD said to me, "Son of man, mark well, see with your eyes, and hear with your ears all that I shall tell you concerning all the statutes of the temple of the LORD and all its laws. And mark well the entrance to the temple and all the exits from the sanctuary.

Ezk\_44:24 In a dispute, they shall act as judges, and they shall judge it according to my judgments. They shall keep my laws and my statutes in all my appointed feasts, and they shall keep my Sabbaths holy.

Amo\_2:4 Thus says the LORD: "For three transgressions of Judah, and for four, I will not revoke the punishment, because they have rejected the law of the LORD, and have not kept his statutes, but their lies have led them astray, those after which their fathers walked.

Mic\_6:16 For you have kept the statutes of Omri, and all the works of the house of Ahab; and you have walked in their counsels, that I may make you a desolation, and your inhabitants a hissing; so you shall bear the scorn of my people."

Zec\_1:6 But my words and my statutes, which I commanded my servants the prophets, did they not overtake your fathers? So they repented and said, 'As the LORD of hosts purposed to deal with us for our ways and deeds, so has he dealt with us."

Mal\_3:7 From the days of your fathers you have turned aside from my statutes and have not kept them. Return to me, and I will return to you, says the LORD of hosts. But you say, 'How shall we return?'

Mal\_4:4 "Remember the law of my servant Moses, the statutes and rules that I commanded him at Horeb for all Israel.

Luk\_1:6 And they were both righteous before God, walking blamelessly in all the commandments and statutes of the Lord.

## **Commandments**

Gen\_26:5 because Abraham obeyed my voice and kept my charge, my commandments, my statutes, and my laws."

Exo\_15:26 saying, "If you will diligently listen to the voice of the LORD your God, and do that which is right in his eyes, and give ear to his commandments and keep all his statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you that I put on the Egyptians, for I am the LORD, your healer."

Exo\_16:28 And the LORD said to Moses, "How long will you refuse to keep my commandments and my laws?

Exo\_20:6 but showing steadfast love to thousands of those who love me and keep my commandments.

Exo\_34:28 So he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights. He neither ate bread nor drank water. And he wrote on the tablets the words of the covenant, the Ten Commandments.

Lev\_4:2 "Speak to the people of Israel, saying, If anyone sins unintentionally in any of the LORD's commandments about things not to be done, and does any one of them,

Lev\_4:13 "If the whole congregation of Israel sins unintentionally and the thing is hidden from the eyes of the assembly, and they do any one of the things that by the LORD's commandments ought not to be done, and they realize their guilt,

Lev\_4:22 "When a leader sins, doing unintentionally any one of all the things that by the commandments of the LORD his God ought not to be done, and realizes his guilt,

Lev\_4:27 "If anyone of the common people sins unintentionally in doing any one of the things that by the LORD's commandments ought not to be done, and realizes his guilt,

Lev\_5:17 "If anyone sins, doing any of the things that by the LORD's commandments ought not to be done, though he did not know it, then realizes his guilt, he shall bear his iniquity.

Lev\_22:31 "So you shall keep my commandments and do them: I am the LORD.

Lev\_26:3 "If you walk in my statutes and observe my commandments and do them,

Lev\_26:14 "But if you will not listen to me and will not do all these commandments,

Lev\_26:15 if you spurn my statutes, and if your soul abhors my rules, so that you will not do all my commandments, but break my covenant,

Lev\_27:34 These are the commandments that the LORD commanded Moses for the people of Israel on Mount Sinai.

Num\_15:22 "But if you sin unintentionally, and do not observe all these commandments that the LORD has spoken to Moses,

Num\_15:39 And it shall be a tassel for you to look at and remember all the commandments of the LORD, to do them, not to follow after your own heart and your own eyes, which you are inclined to whoredom after.

Num\_15:40 So you shall remember and do all my commandments, and be holy to your God.

Num\_36:13 These are the commandments and the rules that the LORD commanded through Moses to the people of Israel in the plains of Moab by the Jordan at Jericho.

Deu\_4:2 You shall not add to the word that I command you, nor take from it, that you may keep the commandments of the LORD your God that I command you.

Deu\_4:13 And he declared to you his covenant, which he commanded you to perform, that is, the Ten Commandments, and he wrote them on two tablets of stone.

Deu\_4:40 Therefore you shall keep his statutes and his commandments, which I command you today, that it may go well with you and with your children after you, and that you may prolong your days in the land that the LORD your God is giving you for all time."

Deu\_5:10 but showing steadfast love to thousands of those who love me and keep my commandments.

Deu\_5:29 Oh that they had such a heart as this always, to fear me and to keep all my commandments, that it might go well with them and with their descendants forever!

Deu\_6:2 that you may fear the LORD your God, you and your son and your son's son, by keeping all his statutes and his commandments, which I command you, all the days of your life, and that your days may be long.

Deu\_6:17 You shall diligently keep the commandments of the LORD your God, and his testimonies and his statutes, which he has commanded you.

Deu\_7:9 Know therefore that the LORD your God is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments, to a thousand generations,

Deu\_8:2 And you shall remember the whole way that the LORD your God has led you these forty years in the wilderness, that he might humble you, testing you to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep his commandments or not.

Deu\_8:6 So you shall keep the commandments of the LORD your God by walking in his ways and by fearing him.

Deu\_8:11 "Take care lest you forget the LORD your God by not keeping his commandments and his rules and his statutes, which I command you today,

Deu\_10:4 And he wrote on the tablets, in the same writing as before, the Ten Commandments that the LORD had spoken to you on the mountain out of the midst of the fire on the day of the assembly. And the LORD gave them to me.

Deu\_10:13 and to keep the commandments and statutes of the LORD, which I am commanding you today for your good?

Deu\_11:1 "You shall therefore love the LORD your God and keep his charge, his statutes, his rules, and his commandments always.

Deu\_11:13 "And if you will indeed obey my commandments that I command you today, to love the LORD your God, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul,

Deu\_11:27 the blessing, if you obey the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you today,

Deu\_11:28 and the curse, if you do not obey the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside from the way that I am commanding you today, to go after other gods that you have not known.

Deu\_13:4 You shall walk after the LORD your God and fear him and keep his commandments and obey his voice, and you shall serve him and hold fast to him.

Deu\_13:18 if you obey the voice of the LORD your God, keeping all his commandments that I am commanding you today, and doing what is right in the sight of the LORD your God.

Deu\_26:13 then you shall say before the LORD your God, 'I have removed the sacred portion out of my house, and moreover, I have given it to the Levite, the sojourner, the fatherless, and the widow, according to all your commandment that you have commanded me. I have not transgressed any of your commandments, nor have I forgotten them.'

Deu\_26:17 You have declared today that the LORD is your God, and that you will walk in his ways, and keep his statutes and his commandments and his rules, and will obey his voice.

Deu\_26:18 And the LORD has declared today that you are a people for his treasured possession, as he has promised you, and that you are to keep all his commandments,

Deu\_27:10 You shall therefore obey the voice of the LORD your God, keeping his commandments and his statutes, which I command you today."

Deu\_28:1 "And if you faithfully obey the voice of the LORD your God, being careful to do all his commandments that I command you today, the LORD your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth.

Deu\_28:9 The LORD will establish you as a people holy to himself, as he has sworn to you, if you keep the commandments of the LORD your God and walk in his ways.

Deu\_28:13 And the LORD will make you the head and not the tail, and you shall only go up and not down, if you obey the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you today, being careful to do them,

Deu\_28:15 "But if you will not obey the voice of the LORD your God or be careful to do all his commandments and his statutes that I command you today, then all these curses shall come upon you and overtake you.

Deu\_28:45 "All these curses shall come upon you and pursue you and overtake you till you are destroyed, because you did not obey the voice of the LORD your God, to keep his commandments and his statutes that he commanded you.

Deu\_30:8 And you shall again obey the voice of the LORD and keep all his commandments that I command you today.

Deu\_30:10 when you obey the voice of the LORD your God, to keep his commandments and his statutes that are written in this Book of the Law, when you turn to the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.

Deu\_30:16 If you obey the commandments of the LORD your God that I command you today, by loving the LORD your God, by walking in his ways, and by keeping his commandments and his statutes and his rules, then you shall live and multiply, and the LORD your God will bless you in the land that you are entering to take possession of it.

Jos\_22:5 Only be very careful to observe the commandment and the law that Moses the servant of the LORD commanded you, to love the LORD your God, and to walk in all his ways and to keep his commandments and to cling to him and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul."

Jdg\_2:17 Yet they did not listen to their judges, for they whored after other gods and bowed down to them. They soon turned aside from the way in which their fathers had walked, who had obeyed the commandments of the LORD, and they did not do so.

Jdg\_3:4 They were for the testing of Israel, to know whether Israel would obey the commandments of the LORD, which he commanded their fathers by the hand of Moses.

1Sa\_15:11 "I regret that I have made Saul king, for he has turned back from following me and has not performed my commandments." And Samuel was angry, and he cried to the LORD all night.

1Ki\_2:3 and keep the charge of the LORD your God, walking in his ways and keeping his statutes, his commandments, his rules, and his testimonies, as it is written in the Law of Moses, that you may prosper in all that you do and wherever you turn,

1Ki\_3:14 And if you will walk in my ways, keeping my statutes and my commandments, as your father David walked, then I will lengthen your days."

1Ki\_6:12 "Concerning this house that you are building, if you will walk in my statutes and obey my rules and keep all my commandments and walk in them, then I will establish my word with you, which I spoke to David your father.

1Ki\_8:58 that he may incline our hearts to him, to walk in all his ways and to keep his commandments, his statutes, and his rules, which he commanded our fathers.

1Ki\_8:61 Let your heart therefore be wholly true to the LORD our God, walking in his statutes and keeping his commandments, as at this day."

1Ki\_9:6 But if you turn aside from following me, you or your children, and do not keep my commandments and my statutes that I have set before you, but go and serve other gods and worship them,

1Ki\_11:34 Nevertheless, I will not take the whole kingdom out of his hand, but I will make him ruler all the days of his life, for the sake of David my servant whom I chose, who kept my commandments and my statutes.

1Ki\_11:38 And if you will listen to all that I command you, and will walk in my ways, and do what is right in my eyes by keeping my statutes and my commandments, as David my servant did, I will be with you and will build you a sure house, as I built for David, and I will give Israel to you.

1Ki\_14:8 and tore the kingdom away from the house of David and gave it to you, and yet you have not been like my servant David, who kept my commandments and followed me with all his heart, doing only that which was right in my eyes,

1Ki\_18:18 And he answered, "I have not troubled Israel, but you have, and your father's house, because you have abandoned the commandments of the LORD and followed the Baals.

2Ki\_17:13 Yet the LORD warned Israel and Judah by every prophet and every seer, saying, "Turn from your evil ways and keep my commandments and my statutes, in accordance with all the Law that I commanded your fathers, and that I sent to you by my servants the prophets."

2Ki\_17:16 And they abandoned all the commandments of the LORD their God, and made for themselves metal images of two calves; and they made an Asherah and worshiped all the host of heaven and served Baal.

2Ki\_17:19 Judah also did not keep the commandments of the LORD their God, but walked in the customs that Israel had introduced.

2Ki\_18:6 For he held fast to the LORD. He did not depart from following him, but kept the commandments that the LORD commanded Moses.

2Ki\_23:3 And the king stood by the pillar and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD and to keep his commandments and his testimonies and his statutes with all his heart and all his soul, to perform the words of this covenant that were written in this book. And all the people joined in the covenant.

1Ch\_28:7 I will establish his kingdom forever if he continues strong in keeping my commandments and my rules, as he is today.'

1Ch\_28:8 Now therefore in the sight of all Israel, the assembly of the LORD, and in the hearing of our God, observe and seek out all the commandments of the LORD your God, that you may possess this good land and leave it for an inheritance to your children after you forever.

1Ch\_29:19 Grant to Solomon my son a whole heart that he may keep your commandments, your testimonies, and your statutes, performing all, and that he may build the palace for which I have made provision."

2Ch\_7:19 "But if you turn aside and forsake my statutes and my commandments that I have set before you, and go and serve other gods and worship them,

2Ch\_17:4 but sought the God of his father and walked in his commandments, and not according to the practices of Israel.

2Ch\_24:20 Then the Spirit of God clothed Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest, and he stood above the people, and said to them, "Thus says God, 'Why do you break the commandments of the LORD, so that you cannot prosper? Because you have forsaken the LORD, he has forsaken you.'"

2Ch\_31:21 And every work that he undertook in the service of the house of God and in accordance with the law and the commandments, seeking his God, he did with all his heart, and prospered.

2Ch\_34:31 And the king stood in his place and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD and to keep his commandments and his testimonies and his statutes, with all his heart and all his soul, to perform the words of the covenant that were written in this book.

Ezr\_7:11 This is a copy of the letter that King Artaxerxes gave to Ezra the priest, the scribe, a man learned in matters of the commandments of the LORD and his statutes for Israel:

Ezr\_9:10 "And now, O our God, what shall we say after this? For we have forsaken your commandments,

Ezr\_9:14 shall we break your commandments again and intermarry with the peoples who practice these abominations? Would you not be angry with us until you consumed us, so that there should be no remnant, nor any to escape?

Neh\_1:5 And I said, "O LORD God of heaven, the great and awesome God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments,

Neh\_1:7 We have acted very corruptly against you and have not kept the commandments, the statutes, and the rules that you commanded your servant Moses.

Neh\_1:9 but if you return to me and keep my commandments and do them, though your outcasts are in the uttermost parts of heaven, from there I will gather them and bring them to the place that I have chosen, to make my name dwell there.'

Neh\_9:13 You came down on Mount Sinai and spoke with them from heaven and gave them right rules and true laws, good statutes and commandments,

Neh\_9:14 and you made known to them your holy Sabbath and commanded them commandments and statutes and a law by Moses your servant.

Neh\_9:16 "But they and our fathers acted presumptuously and stiffened their neck and did not obey your commandments.

Neh\_9:29 And you warned them in order to turn them back to your law. Yet they acted presumptuously and did not obey your commandments, but sinned against your rules, which if a person does them, he shall live by them, and they turned a stubborn shoulder and stiffened their neck and would not obey.

Neh\_9:34 Our kings, our princes, our priests, and our fathers have not kept your law or paid attention to your commandments and your warnings that you gave them.

Neh\_10:29 join with their brothers, their nobles, and enter into a curse and an oath to walk in God's Law that was given by Moses the servant of God, and to observe and do all the commandments of the LORD our Lord and his rules and his statutes.

Psa\_78:7 so that they should set their hope in God and not forget the works of God, but keep his commandments;

Psa\_89:31 if they violate my statutes and do not keep my commandments,

Psa\_103:18 to those who keep his covenant and remember to do his commandments.

Psa\_112:1 Praise the LORD! Blessed is the man who fears the LORD, who greatly delights in his commandments!

Psa\_119:6 Then I shall not be put to shame, having my eyes fixed on all your commandments.

Psa\_119:10 With my whole heart I seek you; let me not wander from your commandments!

Psa\_119:19 I am a sojourner on the earth; hide not your commandments from me!

Psa\_119:21 You rebuke the insolent, accursed ones, who wander from your commandments.

Psa\_119:32 I will run in the way of your commandments when you enlarge my heart!

Psa\_119:35 Lead me in the path of your commandments, for I delight in it.

Psa\_119:47 for I find my delight in your commandments, which I love.

Psa\_119:48 I will lift up my hands toward your commandments, which I love, and I will meditate on your statutes.

Psa\_119:60 I hasten and do not delay to keep your commandments.

Psa\_119:66 Teach me good judgment and knowledge, for I believe in your commandments.

Psa\_119:73 Yodh Your hands have made and fashioned me; give me understanding that I may learn your commandments.

Psa\_119:86 All your commandments are sure; they persecute me with falsehood; help me!

Psa\_119:115 Depart from me, you evildoers, that I may keep the commandments of my God.

Psa\_119:127 Therefore I love your commandments above gold, above fine gold.

Psa\_119:131 I open my mouth and pant, because I long for your commandments.

Psa\_119:143 Trouble and anguish have found me out, but your commandments are my delight.

Psa\_119:151 But you are near, O LORD, and all your commandments are true.

Psa\_119:166 I hope for your salvation, O LORD, and I do your commandments.

Psa\_119:172 My tongue will sing of your word, for all your commandments are right.

Psa\_119:176 I have gone astray like a lost sheep; seek your servant, for I do not forget your commandments.

Pro\_2:1 My son, if you receive my words and treasure up my commandments with you,

Pro\_3:1 My son, do not forget my teaching, but let your heart keep my commandments,

Pro\_4:4 he taught me and said to me, "Let your heart hold fast my words; keep my commandments, and live.

Pro\_7:1 My son, keep my words and treasure up my commandments with you;

Pro\_7:2 keep my commandments and live; keep my teaching as the apple of your eye;

Pro\_10:8 The wise of heart will receive commandments, but a babbling fool will come to ruin.

Ecc\_12:13 The end of the matter; all has been heard. Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man.

Isa\_48:18 Oh that you had paid attention to my commandments! Then your peace would have been like a river, and your righteousness like the waves of the sea;

Dan\_9:4 I prayed to the LORD my God and made confession, saying, "O Lord, the great and awesome God, who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments,

Dan\_9:5 we have sinned and done wrong and acted wickedly and rebelled, turning aside from your commandments and rules.

Mat\_5:19 Therefore whoever relaxes one of the least of these commandments and teaches others to do the same will be called least in the kingdom of heaven, but whoever does them and teaches them will be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

Mat\_15:9 in vain do they worship me, teaching as doctrines the commandments of men."

Mat\_19:17 And he said to him, "Why do you ask me about what is good? There is only one who is good. If you would enter life, keep the commandments."

Mat\_22:40 On these two commandments depend all the Law and the Prophets."

Mrk\_7:7 in vain do they worship me, teaching as doctrines the commandments of men.'

Mrk\_10:19 You know the commandments: 'Do not murder, Do not commit adultery, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Do not defraud, Honor your father and mother.'

Luk\_1:6 And they were both righteous before God, walking blamelessly in all the commandments and statutes of the Lord.

Luk\_18:20 You know the commandments: 'Do not commit adultery, Do not murder, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Honor your father and mother.'

Jhn\_14:15 "If you love me, you will keep my commandments.

Jhn\_14:21 Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves me. And he who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and manifest myself to him."

Jhn\_15:10 If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love.

Rom\_10:5 For Moses writes about the righteousness that is based on the law, that the person who does the commandments shall live by them.

Rom\_13:9 For the commandments, "You shall not commit adultery, You shall not murder, You shall not steal, You shall not covet," and any other commandment, are summed up in this word: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

1Co\_7:19 For neither circumcision counts for anything nor uncircumcision, but keeping the commandments of God.

Eph\_2:15 by abolishing the law of commandments expressed in ordinances, that he might create in himself one new man in place of the two, so making peace,

1Jn\_2:3 And by this we know that we have come to know him, if we keep his commandments.

1Jn\_2:4 Whoever says "I know him" but does not keep his commandments is a liar, and the truth is not in him,

1Jn\_3:22 and whatever we ask we receive from him, because we keep his commandments and do what pleases him.

1Jn\_3:24 Whoever keeps his commandments abides in God, and God in him. And by this we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit whom he has given us.

1Jn\_5:2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and obey his commandments.


